- 3 requirements to a person at least 70 years of age.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.012(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The commission may set a lower fee or waive the fee or
- 8 license requirement for a resident who is under 17 years old, who is
- 9 65 years old or older, or who is participating in an event that is
- 10 sponsored or co-sponsored by the Texas Parks and Wildlife
- 11 Department with the approval of the executive director. The
- 12 commission shall waive the fee for a qualified disabled veteran and
- for a resident who is at least 70 years of age.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 42.014, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 42.014. NONRESIDENT SPECIAL HUNTING LICENSE FEE. The
- 17 fee for a nonresident special hunting license is \$37.75 or an amount
- 18 set by the commission, whichever amount is more. The commission
- shall waive the fee for a nonresident who is at least 70 years of age
- 20 and whose state of residence grants a similar age waiver to Texas
- 21 <u>residents.</u>
- SECTION 3. Section 42.0141, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 42.0141. GENERAL NONRESIDENT HUNTING LICENSE

- 1 FEE. The fee for a general nonresident hunting license is \$100.75
- or an amount set by the commission, whichever amount is more. The
- 3 commission shall waive the fee for a nonresident who is at least 70
- 4 years of age and whose state of residence grants a similar age
- 5 waiver to Texas residents.
- 6 SECTION 4. Section 42.0142(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The fee for a nonresident banded bird hunting license is
- 9 an amount set by the commission. The commission shall waive the fee
- 10 for a nonresident who is at least 70 years of age and whose state of
- 11 residence grants a similar age waiver to Texas residents.
- 12 SECTION 5. Section 42.0143, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 42.0143. NONRESIDENT FIVE-DAY SPECIAL HUNTING
- 15 LICENSE. A nonresident five-day special hunting license is valid
- 16 for five consecutive days. The fee for the license is set by the
- 17 commission in an amount not to exceed 50 percent of the amount of
- 18 the fee set for a nonresident special hunting license. The
- 19 commission shall waive the fee for a nonresident who is at least 70
- 20 years of age and whose state of residence grants a similar age
- 21 waiver to Texas residents.
- SECTION 6. Section 42.0144, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 42.0144. NONRESIDENT SPRING TURKEY HUNTING LICENSE
- 25 FEE. The fee for a nonresident spring turkey hunting license is
- \$75 or an amount set by the commission, whichever amount is more.
- 27 The commission shall waive the fee for a nonresident who is at least

- 1 70 years of age and whose state of residence grants a similar age
- 2 waiver to Texas residents.
- 3 SECTION 7. Chapter 43, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended
- 4 by adding Subchapter A to read as follows:
- 5 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
- 6 Sec. 43.001. EXEMPTIONS. A stamp required under this
- 7 <u>chapter does not apply to:</u>
- 8 (1) a resident as defined by Section 42.001 who is at
- 9 least 70 years of age; or
- 10 (2) a nonresident as defined by Section 42.001 who is
- 11 at least 70 years of age and whose state of residence grants a
- 12 similar age exemption to Texas residents.
- SECTION 8. Section 46.002(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) A license issued under this chapter is not required of a
- 16 person:
- 17 (1) who is a resident and who is at least 70 years of
- 18 age [and whose birth date is before September 1, 1930];
- 19 (2) who is a nonresident <u>and who is at least 70 years</u>
- 20 of age[, if the person's birth date is before September 1, 1930,
- 21 and whose [the person's] state of residence grants a similar age
- 22 exemption to Texas residents;
- 23 (3) who is mentally disabled and who is engaging in
- recreational fishing as part of medically approved therapy, and who
- is fishing under the immediate supervision of personnel approved or
- 26 employed by a hospital, residence, or school for mentally disabled
- 27 persons;

- 1 (4) who is mentally retarded and is engaged in
- 2 recreational fishing under the immediate supervision of a person
- 3 who:
- 4 (A) holds a license issued under this chapter;
- 5 and
- 6 (B) has the permission of the mentally retarded
- 7 person's family head or legal guardian to take the mentally
- 8 retarded person fishing if the person is not a member of the family
- 9 of the mentally retarded person; or
- 10 (5) who is participating in an event that is sponsored
- or co-sponsored by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department with the
- 12 approval of the Executive Director.
- SECTION 9. Section 50.002(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) The fee for the combination license is \$12 or an amount
- 16 set by the commission, whichever amount is more. The commission
- 17 shall waive the fee for a resident who is at least 70 years of age.
- SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
