- 18 (5) identify staff needed to implement the plan;
- 19 (6) set timelines for reaching the goals;
- 20 (7) measure progress toward the performance 21 objectives periodically to ensure that the plan is resulting in 22 academic improvement;
- 23 (8) <u>establish</u> [<u>include</u>] goals and <u>research-based</u> 24 methods for violence prevention and intervention on campus that

- 1 include ongoing, research-based teacher development programs that
- 2 focus on:
- 3 (A) developing healthy self-esteem in students;
- 4 and
- 5 (B) creating a nurturing classroom environment;
- 6 and
- 7 (9) provide for a program to encourage parental
- 8 involvement at the campus that includes research-based classes and
- 9 training in nurturing and providing positive discipline to a child.
- SECTION 2. Section 11.253(d), Education Code, as amended by
- 11 this Act, applies to campus improvement plans beginning with campus
- improvement plans for the 2004-2005 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
