1-7 Amend H.B. No. 387 as follows:

1-8 (1) In SECTION 1 of the bill, in proposed Section 11.253,  
1-9 Education Code, add "(k) a district may identify external  
1-10 organizations to assist in the development and execution of any  
1-11 program within this plan."

1-12 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-13 AN ACT

1-14 relating to public school campus improvement plans.

1-15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-16 SECTION 1. Section 11.253, Education Code, is amended by  
1-17 adding Subsections (i) and (j) to read as follows:

1-18 (i) The goals and methods for violence prevention and  
1-19 intervention that are included in a campus improvement plan under  
1-20 Subsection (d)(8) may include ongoing, research-based teacher  
1-21 development programs that focus on:

1-22 (1) developing healthy self-esteem in students; and

1-23 (2) creating a nurturing classroom environment.

1-24 (j) The program to encourage parental involvement that is  
1-25 provided for by a campus improvement plan under Subsection (d)(9)  
1-26 may include research-based classes and training in nurturing and  
1-27 providing positive discipline to a child.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
