1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to a pilot program involving the use of an electronic
1-9 registration system.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Chapter 63, Election Code, is amended by adding
1-12 Section 63.013 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 63.013. (a) The secretary of state shall implement a
1-14 pilot program to evaluate the use of an electronic registration
1-15 system on election day and during the period for early voting by
1-16 personal appearance. The program shall:

1-17 (1) be limited to a single county that chooses to
1-18 participate and has a population of approximately 500,000 people;

1-19 (2) allow for the use of a card with a magnetic stripe
1-20 issued to the voter to confirm the voter's registration instead of
1-21 the registration certificate when the voter appears in person to
1-22 vote; and

1-23 (3) be used in one or more countywide elections as
1-24 determined appropriate by the secretary of state and the county.

1-25 (b) At the conclusion of the pilot program established under
1-26 Subsection (a), but not later than December 31, 2006, the secretary
1-27 of state shall file a report with the governor, the lieutenant
1-28 governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives on the
1-29 pilot program and the use of an electronic registration card. The
1-30 report may contain recommendations on the future use of the card and
1-31 suggestions for permanent statutory authority regarding the use of
1-32 the card.

1-33 (c) This section expires January 1, 2007.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
