- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 130.008(d), Education Code, is repealed.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 42.005, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 8 (g) If a student may receive course credit toward the
- 9 student's high school academic requirements and toward the
- 10 student's higher education academic requirements for a single
- 11 course, the time during which the student attends the course may not
- 12 be counted as part of the minimum number of instructional hours
- 13 required for a student to be considered a full-time student in
- 14 average daily attendance for purposes of this section. This
- subsection expires September 1, 2004.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
