A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to state funding of courses offered for joint high school
3 and junior college credit.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 130.008(d), Education Code, is repealed.

6 SECTION 2. Section 42.005, Education Code, is amended by
7 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

8 (g) If a student may receive course credit toward the
9 student's high school academic requirements and toward the
10 student's higher education academic requirements for a single
11 course, the time during which the student attends the course may not
12 be counted as part of the minimum number of instructional hours
13 required for a student to be considered a full-time student in
14 average daily attendance for purposes of this section. This
15 subsection expires September 1, 2004.

16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
