19	SECTION 3. Sections 241.051(d) and (e), Health and Safety			
20	Code, are amended to read as follows:

23	investigation <u>that is</u> [concerning a hospital are] confidential <u>by</u>

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under Chapter 552 [Section 552.001 et seq.], Government Code[, and 1 not subject to disclosure, discovery, subpoena, or other means of 2 legal compulsion for their release to anyone other than the 3 department or its employees or agents involved in the enforcement 4 action except that this information may be disclosed to: 5 [(1) persons involved with the department in the 6 7 enforcement action against the hospital; [(2) the hospital that is the subject of the 8 9 enforcement action, or the hospital's authorized representative; [(3) appropriate state or federal agencies that are 10 authorized to inspect, survey, or investigate hospital services; 11 [(4) law enforcement agencies; and 12 [(5) persons engaged in bona fide research, if all 13 individual-identifying and hospital-identifying information has 14 been deleted]. 15 [(e) The following information is subject to disclosure in 16 accordance with Section 552.001 et seq., Government Code: 17 [(1) a notice of alleged violation against the 18 hospital, which notice shall include the provisions of law which 19 the hospital is alleged to have violated, and a general statement of 20 the nature of the alleged violation; 21 22 [(2) the pleadings in the administrative proceeding; 23 and 24 [(3) a final decision or order by the department.] 25 SECTION 4. Sections 577.013(d) and (e), Health and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows: 26 Information [All information and materials] obtained or 27 (d)

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compiled by the department in connection with a complaint or [and] 1 investigation that is [concerning a mental hospital licensed under 2 this chapter are] confidential by law remains confidential and is 3 [and] not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government 4 Code[, discovery, subpoena, or other means of legal compulsion for 5 6 their release to anyone other than the department or its employees or agents involved in the enforcement action except that this 7 8 information may be disclosed to: [(1) persons involved with the department in the 9 enforcement action against the licensed mental hospital; 10 [(2) the licensed mental hospital that is the subject 11 of the enforcement action, or the licensed mental hospital's 12 authorized representative; 13 [(3) appropriate state or federal agencies that are 14 15 authorized to inspect, survey, or investigate licensed mental hospital services; 16 17 [(4) law enforcement agencies; and [(5) persons engaged in bona fide research, if all 18 individual-identifying information and information identifying the 19 licensed mental hospital has been deleted]. 20 21 [(e) The following information is subject to disclosure in accordance with Section 552.001 et seq., Government Code: 22 [(1) a notice of alleged violation against the 23 24 licensed mental hospital, which notice shall include the provisions of law which the licensed mental hospital is alleged to have 25 violated, and the nature of the alleged violation; 26 [(2) the pleadings in the administrative proceeding; 27
