12	Subsections (e)(1)-(6) is increased to the next higher category of
13	offense if it is shown on the trial of the offense that:
14	(1) the actor was a public servant at the time of the
15	offense and the property appropriated came into the actor's
16	custody, possession, or control by virtue of his status as a public
17	servant; [or]
18	(2) the actor was in a contractual relationship with
19	government at the time of the offense and the property appropriated
20	came into the actor's custody, possession, or control by virtue of
21	the contractual relationship <u>; or</u>
22	(3) the owner of the property appropriated was at the
23	time of the offense an elderly individual.
24	SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies

only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that date.

5 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this 6 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
