H.B. No. 430

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to service of public school superintendents, principals,
3 assistant principals, and other senior administrators as
4 substitute teachers.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
7 amended by adding Section 11.203 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 11.203. ADMINISTRATOR SERVICE AS SUBSTITUTE
9 TEACHER. Each superintendent, principal, assistant principal, and
10 other senior administrator in a school district shall serve as a
11 substitute teacher for a class in the district for at least two days
12 during each school year.

13 SECTION 2. The heading to Subchapter E, Chapter 11,
14 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

15 SUBCHAPTER E. ADMINISTRATORS [~~SUPERINTENDENTS AND PRINCIPALS~~]

16 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
17 school year.

18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
22 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
