- 3 that is collected, assembled, or maintained for purposes of

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 418.175, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 418.175. CERTAIN INFORMATION <u>EXCEPTED FROM PUBLIC</u>
- 9 DISCLOSURE [CONFIDENTIAL]. (a) Information that [relates to
- 10 physically or mentally disabled individuals or other medically
- 11 **fragile individuals and that**] is collected, assembled, or
- 12 maintained for purposes of emergency management or disaster
- 13 planning is [confidential and] excepted from required disclosure
- 14 under Chapter 552 if the person in possession of the information
- 15 <u>believes that disclosure of the information would compromise or</u>
- 16 interfere with implementation of the emergency management or
- 17 disaster plan of the state, an agency or political subdivision of
- 18 the state, or an agency of a political subdivision of the state.
- 19 (b) This section applies to information in the possession of
- 20 any person, including:
- 21 (1) the state, an agency \underline{or} [of the state, a] political
- 22 subdivision of the state, or an agency of a political subdivision of
- 23 the state; or
- 24 (2) an electric, telecommunications, gas, or water

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- 1 utility.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
