- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article 56.54(b), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsections (h), (i), (j), [and]
- 9 (k), and (l) and Article 56.541, the compensation to victims of
- 10 crime fund may be used only by the attorney general for the payment
- of compensation to claimants or victims under this subchapter, the
- 12 operation of the Crime Victims' Institute created by Chapter 412,
- 13 Government Code, and other expenses in administering this
- 14 subchapter.
- 15 SECTION 2. Article 56.54, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- amended by adding Subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 17 (1) The attorney general may use the compensation to victims
- 18 of crime fund to pay an expert witness fee incurred in the
- 19 investigation or prosecution of a criminal case based on physical
- 20 or sexual abuse of a child or the death of a child. The attorney
- 21 general must pay the fee directly from the fund to the expert
- 22 witness. The attorney general may not pay more than \$5,000 from the
- 23 <u>fund for an expert witness fee.</u>
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
