- 1 SECTION 2. Section 875, Texas Probate Code, is amended by
- 2 amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (l) to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 (h) Except as provided by Subsection (k) or (1) of this
- 5 section, a temporary guardianship may not remain in effect for more
- 6 than 60 days.
- 7 (1) The filing of a recusal motion tolls the 60-day period
- 8 prescribed by Subsection (h) of this section until the date on which
- 9 the order on the recusal motion is rendered.
- 10 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 11 875, Texas Probate Code, apply only to an application for the
- 12 appointment of a temporary guardian filed on or after the effective
- date of this Act. An application for the appointment of a temporary
- 14 guardian filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 15 the law in effect on the date on which the application was filed,
- 16 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
