- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 302.0055, Labor Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 302.0055. [T.E.A.C.H.] PILOT PROGRAM.
- 8 SECTION 2. Sections 302.0055(a) and (e), Labor Code, are
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) The commission shall establish a pilot program [ $\frac{1}{2}$  to be
- 11 known as the Teacher Education and Compensation Helps (T.E.A.C.H.)
- 12 pilot program, to assist teachers in retaining employment in the
- 13 field of child care. In establishing and administering the
- 14 program, the commission may consult with nationally recognized [any
- 15 other] early childhood teacher pilot programs [program].
- 16 (e) Not later than December 1 of each year, the commission
- 17 shall submit a report to the governor and the legislature regarding
- the status and results of the [T.E.A.C.H.] pilot program.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
