NONPROFIT AND CIVIC ORGANIZATIONS. 7 This chapter does not apply to: 8 a nonprofit business or civic organization that: 9 (1)employs a peace officer who meets the 10 (A) qualifications of Section 1702.322(1) as a patrolman, guard, or 11 12 watchman; 13 provides the services of the peace officer (B) 14 only to: 15 (i) the organization's members; or (ii) if the organization does not have 16 members, the members of the communities served by the organization 17 18 as described in the organization's articles of incorporation or other organizational documents; 19 devotes the net receipts from all charges for 20 (C) 21 the services exclusively to the cost of providing the services or to 22 the costs of other services for the enhancement of the security or 23 safety of: 24 (i) the organization's members; or

(ii) if the organization does not have 1 members, the members of the communities served by the organization 2 3 as described in the organization's articles of incorporation or 4 other organizational documents; and 5 (D) does not perform any other service that 6 requires a license under this chapter; [or] 7 (2) а charitable, nonprofit organization that 8 maintains a system of records to aid in the location of missing children and that: 9 is exempt from the payment of federal income 10 (A) taxes under Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and 11 its subsequent amendments by being listed as an exempt entity under 12 Section 501(c)(3) of that code; 13 exclusively provides services related to 14 (B) 15 locating missing children; and (C) does not perform any other service that 16 17 requires a license under this chapter; or (3) a nonprofit business or civic organization that 18 employs or contracts with a person to provide parking guard and 19 other facility management services during an event conducted by the 20 21 business or organization. 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
