- 3 affecting the parent-child relationship.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 102.010, Family Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) In any suit in which service of citation is by
- 8 publication, a statement of the evidence of service, approved and
- 9 signed by the court, must be filed with the papers of the suit as a
- 10 part of the record.
- 11 (e) In a suit filed under Chapter 262, the court may order
- 12 substituted service of citation by publication, including
- 13 publication by posting the citation at the courthouse door for a
- 14 specified time, if the court finds and states in its order that the
- 15 method of substituted service is as likely as citation by
- 16 publication in the manner described by Subsection (c) to give the
- 17 respondent actual notice of the suit. If the court orders that
- 18 citation by publication shall be completed by posting the citation
- 19 at the courthouse door for a specified time, service must be
- 20 completed on, and the answer date is computed from, the expiration
- 21 date of the posting period. If the court orders another method of
- 22 substituted service of citation by publication, service shall be
- 23 completed as directed by the court.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and

- 1 applies only to a suit affecting the parent-child relationship
- 2 filed on or after that date. A suit affecting the parent-child
- 3 relationship filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 4 governed by the law in effect on the date that the suit was filed,
- 5 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
