- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 64, Health and Safety Code, is amended by 6 adding Section 64.002 to read as follows:
- Sec. 64.002. HEALTH CARE SERVICES FOR CERTAIN IMMIGRANTS. A municipality, a county, or a public hospital may use money from
- 9 state or local sources to provide health care services and
- 10 assistance to a person without regard to the person's immigration
- 11 status.

- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 285, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 13 by adding Subchapter M to read as follows:
- 14 SUBCHAPTER M. PROVISION OF SERVICES TO CERTAIN IMMIGRANTS
- 15 Sec. 285.201. AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO CERTAIN
- 16 IMMIGRANTS. A hospital district created under general or special
- 17 law may use money from state or local sources to provide medical and
- 18 <u>hospital care to a person without regard to the person's</u>
- 19 immigration status.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
