If license plates issued under this section are lost, 10 (d) stolen, or mutilated, the owner of the vehicle for which the license 11 plates were issued may obtain replacement plates from the 12 department by paying the fee prescribed by Section 502.184(a)(2). 13 14 If the owner of a vehicle registered under this section disposes of 15 the vehicle during the registration year, the owner shall return the special license plates to the department.
