3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
5	is amended by adding Section 502.2737 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 502.2737. TEXAS MASTER GARDENER LICENSE PLATES. (a)
7	The department shall issue specially designed license plates for
8	passenger cars and light trucks that include the seal of the Texas
9	Master Gardener program of Texas Cooperative Extension.
10	(b) The department shall issue license plates under this
11	section to a person who:
12	(1) applies to the assessor-collector of the county in
13	which the person resides on a form provided by the department; and
14	(2) pays an annual fee of \$30, in addition to the fee
15	prescribed by Section 502.161 or 502.162 and, if personalized
16	prestige license plates are issued, in addition to the fee
17	prescribed by Section 502.251.
18	(c) Of each fee collected under Subsection (b)(2), \$8 shall
19	be used by the department only to defray the cost of administering
20	this section. The department shall deposit the remainder of each
21	fee collected to the credit of an account in the general revenue
22	fund that may be appropriated only to Texas Cooperative Extension
23	for graduate student assistantships within the Texas Master
