- 5 SECTION 1. Section 133.901, Natural Resources Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 133.901. DISTANCE BETWEEN PIT AND PROPERTY LINE. (a)
- 8 Except as provided by Subsection (b), at [This section applies only
- 9 to a county with a population of more than 400,000 and less than
- 10 475,000.
- 11 [(b) At] the time quarrying is completed, the distance from
- 12 the edge of the consolidated material of a pit that does not have
- 13 lateral support to the property line of the nearest property that is
- 14 not owned or leased by the operator may not be less than 50 feet.
- 15 <u>(b)</u> This section does not apply:
- 16 (1) to a pit if the operator and the adjacent property
- owner agree that the pit may be located closer to the property line;
- 18 <u>or</u>
- 19 <u>(2) to an excavation constructed by a political</u>
- 20 <u>subdivision to provide drainage or stormwater retention</u>.
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to a pit that is active on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 23 A pit that is inactive on the effective date of this Act and that
- 24 continuously remains inactive after that date is governed by the

- 1 law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 2 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
