- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 46.004(b) and (c), Parks and Wildlife
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The commission may establish a lower fee or waive the
- 8 fee or license requirement for:
- 9 (1) a resident who has a general commercial
- 10 fisherman's license of this state;
- 11 (2) a resident who is blind as defined by Section
- 12 94.001, Human Resources Code;
- 13 (3) a [resident or] nonresident who is under 17 years
- 14 old; or
- 15 (4) a [resident or] nonresident who is 65 years old or
- 16 over.
- 17 (c) The commission shall waive the fee for:
- 18 <u>(1) a resident who is under 17 years old;</u>
- 19 (2) a resident who is 65 years old or older; and
- 20 <u>(3)</u> a qualified disabled veteran as defined by Section
- 21 42.012.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
