A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to grievance procedures regarding compensation and 3 expenses for county and precinct officers. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 152.013(c), Local Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (c) Before filing the annual budget with the county clerk, 7 the commissioners court shall give written notice to each elected 8 county and precinct officer of the officer's salary, office and 9 travel expenses, or other allowances [and personal expenses] to be 10 11 included in the budget. SECTION 2. Section 152.016, Local Government Code, 12 is 13 amended to read as follows: Sec. 152.016. FUNCTIONS OF GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE IN RELATION 14 15 TO ELECTED OFFICERS. (a) An elected county or precinct officer who is aggrieved by the setting of the officer's salary, office and 16 travel expenses, or other allowances in the county's proposed 17 18 annual budget [or personal expenses] may request a hearing before the salary grievance committee before the approval of the county's 19 annual budget. The request must: 20 21 (1) be in writing; 22 (2) be delivered to the committee chairman within five days after the date the officer receives notice of the proposed 23 24 salary, expenses, or other allowances [or personal expenses]; and

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1 (3) state the desired change in salary, expenses, or
2 <u>other allowances</u> [or personal expenses].

3 (b) The committee shall hold a public hearing within 10 days 4 after the date the request is received. The chairman shall announce 5 the time and place of the hearing.

6 (c) If, after the hearing, [six or more of] the members vote on whether to recommend an increase in the officer's salary, office 7 and travel expenses, or other allowances [or personal expenses], 8 9 the committee shall recommend to submit its vote [recommendation] to the commissioners court in writing. If six to eight members vote 10 to recommend <u>an</u> [the] increase, the commissioners court shall 11 consider the recommendation at its next meeting. If nine members 12 vote to recommend an [the] increase and sign the recommendation, 13 the commissioners court shall include the increase in the budget 14 15 before the budget is filed and the increase takes effect in the next budget year. 16

17 (d) The committee's authority is limited to the consideration of increases in the salaries, office and travel 18 expenses, or other allowances related directly to the official 19 duties [or personal expenses] of county and precinct officers that 20 21 are expressly included in the officer's request for a hearing before the committee. The committee may not set policy of the 22 county or add new items to a proposed county budget. 23

24 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 152, Local Government 25 Code, is amended by adding Section 152.0165 to read as follows:

26Sec. 152.0165.EXHAUSTION OF REMEDIES BEFORE FILING SUIT27REGARDING GRIEVANCE. (a) An elected county or precinct officer

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1	may not file suit regarding the officer's salary, office and travel
2	expenses, or other allowances unless a hearing has been requested
3	and held under Section 152.016.
4	(b) This section does not affect a defense, immunity, or

5 jurisdictional bar available to a county or a county official or 6 employee that is sued by a county or precinct officer based on the 7 officer's salary, office and travel expenses, or other allowances.

8 SECTION 4. (a) The changes made by this Act to Section 9 152.016, Local Government Code, apply only to a hearing that begins 10 on or after the effective date of this Act. A hearing that began 11 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in 12 effect immediately before that date, and that law is continued in 13 effect for that purpose.

(b) Section 152.0165, Local Government Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a civil action filed on or after the effective date of this Act. An action filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
