## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT	

- 2 relating to possession of knives by students on public school
- 3 grounds or at school-sponsored events.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.007(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) A student may be expelled if the student:
- 8 (1) engages in conduct involving a public school that
- 9 contains the elements of the offense of false alarm or report under
- 10 Section 42.06, Penal Code, or terroristic threat under Section
- 11 22.07, Penal Code; or
- 12 (2) while on school property or while attending a
- 13 school-sponsored or school-related activity on or off of school
- 14 property:
- 15 (A) sells, gives, or delivers to another person
- or possesses, uses, or is under the influence of any amount of:
- 17 (i) marihuana or a controlled substance, as
- defined by Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code, or by 21 U.S.C.
- 19 Section 801 et seq.;
- 20 (ii) a dangerous drug, as defined by
- 21 Chapter 483, Health and Safety Code; or
- 22 (iii) an alcoholic beverage, as defined by
- 23 Section 1.04, Alcoholic Beverage Code;
- 24 (B) engages in conduct that contains the elements

- of an offense relating to <u>an</u> abusable <u>volatile chemical</u> [glue or
- 2 aerosol paint] under Sections 485.031 through 485.034 [485.035],
- 3 Health and Safety Code [, or relating to volatile chemicals under
- 4 Chapter 484, Health and Safety Code]; [or]
- 5 (C) engages in conduct that contains the elements
- 6 of an offense under Section 22.01(a)(1), Penal Code, against a
- 7 school district employee or a volunteer as defined by Section
- 8 22.053; or
- 9 (D) possesses a knife other than a knife
- 10 prohibited by Subsection (a).
- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
- amended by adding Section 37.085 to read as follows:
- Sec. 37.085. POSSESSION OF KNIVES. (a) Except as provided
- 14 by Subsection (c), a student may not possess a knife of any type
- 15 while on school property or while attending a school-sponsored or
- school-related activity on or off school property.
- 17 (b) A school district may establish disciplinary measures
- 18 to be imposed for a violation of this section. The disciplinary
- measures must be consistent with requirements relating to expulsion
- 20 of a student or placement of a student in an alternative education
- 21 <u>program under Subchapter A.</u>
- (c) This section does not prohibit possession of a knife
- 23 provided by or permitted by a school district while the knife is
- 24 being used for the purpose authorized by the district.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 26 school year.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
