In order to ensure that students understand and appreciate 8 the histories of the United States and Texas, an educator at an 9 elementary or secondary school, including an open-enrollment 10 charter school, may read from or display any of the following 11 12 historical texts in the school building in which the educator is 13 employed: 14 (1) the United States national motto; (2) the United States national anthem; 15 (3) the United States pledge of allegiance; 16 (4) the preamble to the Texas Constitution; 17 18 (5) the United States Declaration of Independence; 19 (6) the Mayflower Compact; (7) any writings, speeches, documents, or 20 21 proclamations of the original signers of the United States Declaration of Independence or presidents of the United States; 22
