5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 28.010 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 28.010. READING FROM OR DISPLAY OF CERTAIN HISTORICAL
8	TEXTS. In order to ensure that students understand and appreciate
9	the histories of the United States and Texas, an educator at an
10	elementary or secondary school, including an open-enrollment
11	charter school, may read from or display any of the following
12	historical texts in the school building in which the educator is
13	<pre>employed:</pre>
14	(1) the United States national motto;
15	(2) the United States national anthem;
16	(3) the United State pledge of allegiance;
17	(4) the preamble to the Texas Constitution;
18	(5) the United States Declaration of Independence;
19	(6) the Mayflower Compact;
20	(7) any writings, speeches, documents, or
21	proclamations of the Founding Fathers or presidents of the United
22	States;
23	(8) any published decision of the United States
24	Supreme Court or Texas Supreme Court; or

- 2 <u>States Congress or Texas Legislature.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
