A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the membership of the Board of Protective and
- 3 Regulatory Services.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 40.021(a) and (b), Human Resources
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The board is composed of \underline{seven} [\underline{six}] members appointed
- 8 by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate. The
- 9 governor shall designate one member to be the presiding officer of
- 10 the board to serve in that capacity at the pleasure of the governor.
- 11 (b) Five [Four] members of the board, one of whom must be a
- 12 person who was a child in the foster care system, must have a
- 13 demonstrated interest in the services provided by the department,
- 14 and two members must represent the public.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 40.024, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 40.024. BOARD TERMS. Members of the board serve
- 18 six-year terms, with the terms of two or three members expiring
- 19 February 1 of each odd-numbered year.
- 20 SECTION 3. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 21 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 22 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 23 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

1 (b) As soon as possible after the effective date of this 2 Act, the governor shall appoint a person who was a child in the 3 foster care system as an additional member to the Board of 4 Protective and Regulatory Services for a term expiring February 1, 5 2009.
