A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the eligibility of certain persons to contract with a 3 state agency. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Sections 2155.004(a), (c), and (e), Government 5 Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) A state agency may not accept a bid or award a contract that includes proposed financial participation by a person who 8 participated, to any extent, [received compensation from the agency 9 to participate] in preparing the specifications or request for 10 proposals on which the bid or contract is based. 11 12 (c) If a state agency determines that an individual or 13 business entity holding a state contract was ineligible to have the 14 contract accepted or awarded under Subsection (a) or (e), the state 15 agency may immediately terminate the contract without further obligation to the vendor. 16 A state agency may not accept a bid from or award a 17 (e) 18 contract that is subject to this subtitle to an individual or business entity that is barred from participating in state 19 contracts under Section 2155.077 [This section does not prohibit a 20 21 bidder or contract participant from providing free technical 22 assistance to a state agency]. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section 23 2155.004(a), Government Code, applies only in relation to a 24

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
