A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the selection of alternate public members to serve on
- 3 the committee to review salaries and expenses of elected county or
- 4 precinct officers.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 152.015(b) and (d), Local Government
- 7 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) Before the meeting, the county clerk shall place on a
- 9 separate slip the name of each person who served on a grand jury in
- 10 the county during the preceding calendar year. At the meeting the
- 11 slips shall be folded, placed in an appropriate container, and
- 12 mixed. The county judge shall draw at random a number of slips
- 13 equal to the number of public members needed for the committee and
- 14 shall announce the names on the slips. At the meeting the county
- 15 judge may repeat this process and make a list of alternates. A
- 16 person whose name is drawn becomes a member of the committee or an
- 17 alternate on submitting written acceptance to the clerk. If a
- 18 person refuses or is unable to serve on the committee, a replacement
- 19 shall be appointed from the list of alternates. If the list of
- 20 <u>alternates is exhausted or does not exist, a replacement shall be</u>
- 21 selected at the next regular or called commissioners court meeting
- 22 by random selection of a slip from the remaining slips. This
- 23 process shall be repeated until the required number of public
- 24 members is selected.

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- 1 (d) A vacancy in a public member position shall be filled 2 for the unexpired part of the term by appointment from the list of 3 alternates. If the list of alternates is exhausted or does not 4 exist, a replacement shall be filled by random selection of a slip 5 from the remaining slips at a meeting of the commissioners court.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
