- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.9315 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.9315. UNIFORM GRADING POLICY. Each institution of
- 9 higher education shall ensure that a uniform grading policy is used
- 10 to determine the final course grade for each class or section of the
- 11 same or substantially the same course during an academic year. At a
- 12 minimum, the policy must require that the final grades for each
- 13 section or class of the same course offered during an academic year
- 14 be determined according to the same numeric or other scale.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- academic year, if this Act takes effect on or before August 1, 2003.
- 17 If this Act takes effect after August 1, 2003, this Act applies
- 18 beginning with the 2004 spring semester.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
