A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the issuance of Texas Lions Camp license plates.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,

- is amended by adding Section 502.310 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 502.310. TEXAS LIONS CAMP LICENSE PLATES. (a) The
- 7 department shall issue specially designed Texas Lions Camp license
- 8 plates for passenger cars and light trucks.
- 9 <u>(b) The department shall design the license plates in</u> 10 consultation with the Texas Lions League for Crippled Children.
- 11 <u>(c) The department shall issue license plates under this</u> 12 <u>section to a person who:</u>
- (1) applies to the assessor-collector of the county in
- which the person resides on a form provided by the department; and
- 15 (2) pays an annual fee of \$30, in addition to the fee
- 16 prescribed by Section 502.161 or 502.162 and, if personalized
- 17 prestige license plates are issued, in addition to the fee
- 18 prescribed by Section 502.251.
- (d) Of each fee collected under Subsection (c)(2), \$8 may be
- 20 <u>used by the department only to defray the cost of administering this</u>
- 21 section and the remainder deposited to the credit of the Texas Lions
- 22 Camp account in the state treasury. Money in the account may be
- 23 used only by the Parks and Wildlife Department to support the
- 24 activities of a designated nonprofit organization that is

- accredited by the American Camping Association and is licensed by
- 2 the Texas Department of Health and whose primary purpose is to
- 3 provide, without charge, a camp for physically disabled, hearing or
- 4 vision impaired, and diabetic children who reside in this state,
- 5 regardless of race, religion, or national origin. The Parks and
- 6 Wildlife Department shall establish reporting and other mechanisms
- 7 <u>necessary to ensure that the money is spent only for the purposes</u>
- 8 for which it is dedicated.
- 9 <u>(e) If the owner of a vehicle for which license plates were</u>
- 10 <u>issued under this section disposes of the vehicle during a</u>
- 11 registration year, the owner shall return the specialized license
- 12 plates to the department.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
