(1) are wild animals indigenous to this state; state must 1-17 (2) are distinct from cattle, livestock, exotic 1-18 livestock, and game animals; and 1-19 (3) may be raised and used for: 1-20 1-21 commercial purposes; or the purpose of preserving the bison species. SECTION 2.
