- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 487.054(a), Government Code, is amended

- 2 Sec. 487.0541. INTERAGENCY WORK GROUP. (a) An interagency
- 3 work group is created to:
- 4 (1) develop a process to allow agencies to work
- 5 together on issues that face rural communities;
- 6 (2) discuss and coordinate programs and services
- 7 offered to rural communities and residents of rural communities;
- 8 and
- 9 (3) develop regulatory and legislative
- 10 recommendations that would eliminate duplication and combine
- 11 program services.
- 12 (b) The work group is composed of a representative from each
- 13 agency listed in or participating under Section 487.054(a)
- 14 appointed by the executive head of the agency.
- 15 (c) The work group shall meet at the call of the executive
- 16 <u>director of the office.</u>
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
