- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 2108, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subchapter C to read as follows:

7 SUBCHAPTER C. SAVINGS INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR STATE AGENCY

- 8 Sec. 2108.101. NOTICE. A state agency that spends less
- 9 undedicated general revenue derived from nonfederal sources than is
- 10 appropriated to the agency for a fiscal year shall send to the
- 11 comptroller a notice of the amount of the savings before October 30
- 12 following the end of the fiscal year in which the savings are
- 13 <u>realized.</u>
- 14 Sec. 2108.102. VERIFICATION OF SAVINGS. The comptroller
- shall verify the amount of savings contained in the notice not later
- 16 than the 60th day following the date the comptroller receives the
- 17 notice.
- 18 Sec. 2108.103. RETENTION OF FUNDS. (a) The affected agency
- 19 retains one-half of the amount of savings verified by the
- 20 comptroller, not to exceed two percent of the amount of the
- 21 undedicated general revenue derived from nonfederal sources
- 22 appropriated to the agency for the fiscal year in which the savings
- 23 are realized.
- 24 (b) Savings retained under this section may only be

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- appropriated by the legislature to the affected agency. The agency
 may spend the savings only on an activity or expense that does not:

 (1) create new or expanded services; or
 (2) require ongoing funding at a later date.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
