BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 113.902, Local Government Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 113.902. PROSECUTION TO COLLECT DEBT OWED TO COUNTY; 7 RECOVERY OF ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS. (a) The county treasurer 8 shall direct prosecution for the recovery of any debt owed to the 9 county, as provided by law, and shall supervise the collection of 10 11 the debt. 12 (b) In a proceeding to recover a delinquent debt owed to the

13 <u>county, including a delinquent account, loan, interest payment,</u> 14 <u>tax, charge, fee, fine, penalty, or claim on a judgment, the county</u> 15 <u>attorney may recover reasonable attorney's fees and investigative</u> 16 <u>and court costs incurred on behalf of the county. The county</u> 17 <u>attorney may recover the fees and costs in the same manner as</u> 18 <u>provided by law for a private litigant.</u>

19 (c) This section does not apply to the recovery of a 20 <u>delinquent ad valorem tax owed to the county.</u>

SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies to a proceeding to recover a delinquent debt owed to a county that is brought on or after the effective date of this Act. A proceeding to recover a delinquent debt owed to a county that is brought before

1 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect 2 before the effective date, and that law is continued in effect for 3 that purpose.
