A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the use of appropriations in the Smart Jobs Fund as3 business location incentives; making an appropriation.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. The legislature finds 6 that the use of public funds for the purpose of awarding grants as 7 business location incentives for the diversification of the 8 economy, the elimination of unemployment or underemployment, or the 9 development or expansion of transportation or commerce is in the 10 public interest and serves a public purpose of the state.

SECTION 2. BUSINESS LOCATION INCENTIVES. (a) 11 The Texas 12 Department of Economic Development is authorized to make grants to 13 businesses locating within Texas for the purpose of diversifying 14 the economy, reducing unemployment or underemployment, or developing or expanding transportation or commerce. The department 15 may develop procedures or adopt rules to implement this Act. 16

(b) From the amounts appropriated by Chapter 637, Acts of 17 the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, and Chapter 1515, Acts 18 of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001 (the General 19 Appropriations Act), from Smart Jobs Fund No. 891 to the Texas 20 21 Department of Economic Development in connection with the smart 22 jobs program, the department is authorized to expend the unencumbered amount of \$15,000,000 during the remainder of the 23 fiscal year ending August 31, 2003, for business location 24

(c) The unexpended balance of funds described by Subsection
(b) of this section remaining at the end of the fiscal year ending
August 31, 2003, is appropriated from Smart Jobs Fund No. 891 to the
Texas Department of Economic Development for the fiscal year
beginning September 1, 2003, for business location incentives.

7 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect 8 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members 9 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas 10 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 11 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
