1-7 Amend House Bill 673 as follows:  
1-8 On page 1, line 20, between "parent" and "regarding" insert  
1-9 "or guardian".

1-10 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-11 AN ACT

1-12 relating to parental notification of public school teacher  
1-13 qualifications.

1-14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-15 SECTION 1. Section 21.057, Education Code, is amended by  
1-16 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-17 (e) This section does not apply if a school is required in  
1-18 accordance with Section 1111(h)(6)(B)(ii), No Child Left Behind Act  
1-19 of 2001 (20 U.S.C. Section 6311), and its subsequent amendments, to  
1-20 provide notice to a parent regarding a teacher who is not highly  
1-21 qualified, provided the school provides notice as required by that  
1-22 Act.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-27 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
