4 <u>(3) "Sports participant" means a person who</u> 5 participates in any official capacity with respect to an 6 interscholastic, intercollegiate, or other organized amateur or 7 professional athletic competition and includes an athlete, 8 referee, umpire, linesman, coach, instructor, administrator, or 9 staff member.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 10 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 11 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 12 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 13 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 14 15 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 16 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
