5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 2054, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2054.064 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2054.064. PROTECTION AND USE OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY.
8	(a) The department may:
9	(1) apply for, register, secure, hold, and protect
10	under any law in any jurisdiction:
11	(A) a patent for the invention or discovery of,
12	or improvement to, any process, machine, manufacture, or
13	<pre>composition of matter;</pre>
14	(B) a copyright for an original work of
15	authorship fixed in any tangible medium of expression now known or
16	later developed that can be perceived, reproduced, or otherwise
17	<pre>communicated;</pre>
18	(C) a trademark, service mark, collective mark,
19	or certification mark for a word, name, symbol, device, or slogar
20	that the department uses to identify or distinguish goods or
21	services from other goods and services; or
22	(D) other evidence of protection or exclusivity
23	issued for intellectual property;
24	(2) contract with a person for the reproduction,

- 1 distribution, public performance, display, advertising, sale,
- 2 lease, marketing, licensing, or other distribution of intellectual

- 4 (3) obtain under a contract described by Subdivision
- 5 (2) a royalty, license right, or other appropriate means of

- 8 (4) waive or reduce the amount of compensation secured
- 9 by contract under Subdivision (3) if the department determines that
