5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Article 42.036, Code of Criminal Procedure, is

amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

- 8 (g) A judge may permit a defendant classified as a low-risk
- 9 offender under the classification system developed by the
- 10 Commission on Jail Standards under Section 511.009, Government
- 11 Code, to substitute for community service otherwise required under
- 12 this article one or more payments in the amount of \$50 to any
- 13 governmental entity that administers community service in this
- 14 state. A defendant is considered to have served one day in jail, or
- to have performed eight hours of community service, for each \$50
- 16 contributed under this subsection.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 18 applies to a defendant required to perform community service under
- 19 Article 42.036, Code of Criminal Procedure, before, on, or after
- 20 that date.
