11	(b) A school district may enter into or renew a contract
12	with a business entity in which a district trustee has a substantial
13	<u>interest if:</u>
14	(1) the board of trustees at an open meeting
15	determines, based on credible evidence, that:
16	(A) no other business entity within a 50-mile
17	radius of the school district's central administrative office has
18	offered to provide:
19	(i) the same or better quality goods or
20	services at the same or lower cost; or
21	(ii) the best value for the district; and
22	(B) the goods or services at issue are reasonably
23	<pre>priced;</pre>
24	(2) the school district complies with Section 44.031,

1	Education Code, in entering into the contract; and
2	(3) each trustee who has a substantial interest in the
3	business entity complies with Section 171.004.
4	SECTION 2. Section 171.0041, Local Government Code, as
5	added by this Act, applies only to a contract executed on or after
6	September 1, 2003. A contract executed before September 1, 2003, is
7	governed by the law as it existed on the date the contract was
8	executed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
9	purpose.
10	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
