## 1 business entity complies with Section 171.004.

- SECTION 2. Section 171.0041, Local Government Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a contract executed on or after September 1, 2003. A contract executed before September 1, 2003, is governed by the law as it existed on the date the contract was executed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
