- 17 <u>(c) The department shall charge a fee to each passenger in</u>
 18 <u>the amount necessary to recover the cost of operating the</u>
 19 <u>transportation service.</u>
- 20 <u>(d) The department may contract with a commercial bus</u>
 21 <u>company to operate the transportation service.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
