## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.805(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (c) A general academic teaching institution may review
- 9 other factors in making an admissions decision. A general academic
- 10 teaching institution must consider the same factors and apply the
- 11 same standards, criteria, and formulas, including minimum
- 12 standards for high school grade point averages or test scores, to
- 13 all applicants for admission to the institution as entering
- 14 freshmen in ranking those applicants or determining which
- 15 applicants are to be offered admission.
- SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 17 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies beginning
- 18 with undergraduate admissions to a general academic teaching
- 19 institution of higher education for the 2004-2005 academic year.
- 20 Undergraduate admissions to a term or semester before that academic
- 21 year are covered by the law in effect immediately before the
- 22 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 23 effect for that purpose.
