## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain offenses in connection with privileged parking.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 681.001, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subdivision (7) to read as follows:
- 6 (7) "Stand" or "standing" means to halt an occupied or
- 7 <u>unoccupied vehicle</u>, other than temporarily while receiving or
- 8 discharging passengers.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 681.011, Transportation Code, is amended
- 10 by amending Subsections (a)-(c), (e), and (m) to read as follows:
- 11 (a) A person commits an offense if:
- 12 (1) the person <u>stands</u> [parks] a vehicle on which are
- displayed license plates issued under Section 502.253 or 502.254 or
- 14 a disabled parking placard in a parking space or area designated
- 15 specifically for persons with disabilities by:
- 16 (A) a political subdivision; or
- 17 (B) a person who owns or controls private
- 18 property used for parking as to which a political subdivision has
- 19 provided for the application of this section under Subsection (f);
- 20 and
- 21 (2) the standing [parking] of the vehicle in that
- 22 parking space or area is not authorized by Section 681.006,
- 23 681.007, or 681.008.
- 24 (b) A person commits an offense if the person:

- 1 (1) <u>stands</u> [<del>parks</del>] a vehicle on which license plates 2 issued under Section 502.253 or 502.254 are not displayed and a
- 3 disabled parking placard is not displayed in a parking space or area
- 4 designated specifically for individuals with disabilities by:
- 5 (A) a political subdivision; or
- 6 (B) a person who owns or controls private 7 property used for parking as to which a political subdivision has 8 provided for the application of this section under this Subsection
- 9 (f); or
- 10 (2)  $\underline{\text{stands}}$  [ $\underline{\text{parks}}$ ] a vehicle displaying a white on red
- 11 shield disabled parking placard or license plates issued under
- 12 Section 502.253 in a space designated under Section 681.009(e) for
- 13 the exclusive use of vehicles displaying a white on blue shield
- 14 disabled parking placard.
- (c) A person commits an offense if the person stands [parks]
- 16 a vehicle so that the vehicle blocks an architectural improvement

- 19 (e) In a prosecution under this section, it is presumed that
- 20 the registered owner of the motor vehicle is the person who left

- license plates issued under Section 502.253 or a disabled parking

- 2 (2) does not have a disability;
- 3 (3) is not transporting a person with disability; and
- 4 (4) does not pay any applicable fee related to
- 5 standing [parking] in the space or area imposed by a governmental
- 6 unit or exceeds a limitation on the length of time for standing
- 7 [parking] in the space or area.
- 8 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 9 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 10 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 11 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 12 before the effective date.
- 13 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 14 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
