Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by 5 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (i) to read as follows: 7 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), (e), [or] (f), or 8 (i), a school district must pay each classroom teacher, full-time 9 librarian, full-time counselor certified under Subchapter B, or 10 11 full-time school nurse not less than the minimum monthly salary, 12 based on the employee's level of experience, determined by the following formula: 13 14 MS = SF X FS15 where: "MS" is the minimum monthly salary; 16 "SF" is the applicable salary factor specified by Subsection 17 18 (c); and "FS" is the amount, as determined by the commissioner under 19 Subsection (b), of state and local funds per weighted student 20 21 available to a district eligible to receive state assistance under 22 Section 42.302 with an enrichment tax rate, as defined by Section 23 42.302, equal to the maximum rate authorized under Section 42.303, 24 except that the amount of state and local funds per weighted student

does not include the amount attributable to the increase in the guaranteed level made by <u>Chapter 1187</u> [H.B. No. 3343], Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001.

4 (i) A school district in which the average salary for
5 classroom teachers for a school year is greater than the national
6 average salary for classroom teachers for that school year, as
7 determined by the comptroller, is exempt from paying the minimum
8 monthly salary determined under Subsection (a) for the following
9 school year.

10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
