BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 662.005(b), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:

7 (b) Except as provided by Section 662.010, and notwithstanding Section 659.015 or another law, a state employee 8 who is a peace officer commissioned by the Department of Public 9 Safety or who is employed by the Department of Public Safety to 10 perform communications or dispatch services related to traffic law 11 12 enforcement and who is required to work on a national or state 13 holiday that falls on a Saturday or Sunday is entitled to compensatory time off at the rate of one hour for each hour worked 14 15 on the holiday.
