1-8 relating to compensatory time off for certain communications
1-9 service employees of the Department of Public Safety.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 662.005(b), Government Code, is amended
1-12 to read as follows:

1-13 (b) Except as provided by Section 662.010, and
1-14 notwithstanding Section 659.015 or another law, a state employee
1-15 who is a peace officer commissioned by the Department of Public
1-16 Safety or who is employed by the Department of Public Safety to
1-17 perform communications or dispatch services related to traffic law
1-18 enforcement and who is required to work on a national or state
1-19 holiday that falls on a Saturday or Sunday is entitled to
1-20 compensatory time off at the rate of one hour for each hour worked
1-21 on the holiday.

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
