## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- relating to the authority of certain municipalities to impose term limits on the members of their governing bodies.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 26, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 26.047 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 26.047. TERM LIMITS IN POPULOUS MUNICIPALITIES.
- 8 (a) This section applies only to a municipality with a population
- 9 of 1.8 million or more.

- 10 (b) In this section:
- 11 (1) "Governing body of a municipality" includes the
  12 mayor of the municipality.
- 13 (2) "Municipal term limit" means a provision in a
- 14 municipal charter or ordinance that imposes a limit on the number of
- terms or otherwise restricts the length of service a member of the
- 16 governing body of a municipality may serve on the governing body.
- 17 (c) The mayor of a municipality shall order an election in
- 18 the municipality on the first November uniform election date that
- 19 occurs in an even-numbered year after this section becomes
- 20 applicable to the municipality on the question of imposing term
- 21 limits on the members of the governing body of the municipality.
- 22 (d) The ballot at the election must be printed to permit
- voting for or against the proposition: "Authorizing term limits on
- 24 a person's service on the governing body of the municipality."

- 1 (e) If a majority of the votes received at the election
- 2 favor the proposition, the number of cumulative terms a person may
- 3 serve on the governing body may be limited by the municipal charter
- 4 <u>or an ordinance.</u>
- 5 (f) If less than a majority of the votes received at the
- 6 <u>election favor the proposition</u>, the municipality may not impose
- 7 term limits on the members of the governing body.
- 8 (g) In applying a term limit authorized by this section:
- 9 (1) a term to which a member of the governing body was
- 10 elected or appointed before the election held under Subsection (c)
- is counted only if the member served one-half or more of the term;
- 12 and
- 13 (2) a partial term to which a member of the governing
- 14 body is elected or appointed on or after the date of the election
- 15 held under Subsection (c) is counted only if the member serves
- one-half or more of the term.
- 17 (h) This section expires January 1, 2005.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
