- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 242.037, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(i)</u> The minimum standards adopted by the board under this
- 9 section must require that each institution, as part of an existing
- 10 training program, provide each registered nurse, licensed
- 11 vocational nurse, nurse aide, and nursing assistant who provides
- 12 nursing services in the institution at least one hour of training
- each year in caring for people with dementia.
- 14 SECTION 2. It is the intent of the legislature that Section
- 15 242.037(i), Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, and rules
- 16 adopted under that subsection, not impose any training requirement
- 17 that will cause an institution regulated under Chapter 242, Health
- 18 and Safety Code, to incur additional costs.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003. The
- 20 Texas Board of Human Services shall adopt the minimum standard
- 21 required by Section 242.037(i), Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 22 this Act, in time for the standard to take effect on January 1,
- 23 2004.
