5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Property Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 21.0112 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 21.0112. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENT. (a) A
8	governing body of an institution of higher education, as defined by
9	Section 61.003, Education Code, with eminent domain authority that
10	seeks to acquire more than one unit of residential real property by
11	condemnation shall hold a public hearing on the proposed
12	acquisition at which public testimony regarding the proposed
13	acquisition is allowed.
14	(b) The hearing must be held in a location readily
15	accessible to persons who would be affected by the proposed
16	acquisition.
17	(c) Not later than the 30th day before the date of the
18	hearing, the governing body shall, in addition to providing any
19	other notice required by law:

(1) provide notice by registered or certified mail to:

(A) the state senator and state representative

(B) the mayor and each city council member of

- each municipality in which all or part of the property is located;

- 3 (C) the owner of record of each unit of
- 4 residential real property the institution of higher education seeks
- 5 to acquire; and
- 6 (2) publish notice in one or more newspapers of
- 7 general circulation in each county in which all or part of the
- 8 property is located.
- 9 (d) The notice must include:
- 10 (1) the time, date, and location of the hearing;
- 11 (2) the address of each unit of residential real
- 12 property under consideration; and
- 13 (3) the proposed use of the property.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to the acquisition of residential real property by an institution
- of higher education initiated on or after the effective date of this
- 17 Act. The acquisition of residential real property by ar
- 18 institution of higher education initiated before the effective date
- 19 of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 20 acquisition is initiated, and the former law is continued in effect
- 21 for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
