## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- relating to an order by a court that a judgment debtor turn over certain property for the satisfaction of the judgment.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.002, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 7 (h) A court may enter or enforce an order under this section
- 8 that requires the turnover of nonexempt property without
- 9 <u>identifying in the order the specific property subject to turnover.</u>
- 10 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 11 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 12 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 13 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 15 (b) This Act applies to the collection of any judgment,
- 16 without regard to whether the judgment is rendered before, on, or
- 17 after the effective date of this Act.
